The further development and adaption of the interventions is a very important part of the SymfoS methodology.

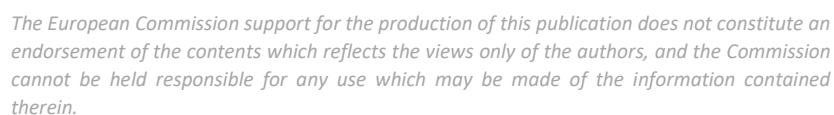
