
1. Future-proof Your Career – the project at a glance

Future-proof your Career aims to design, develop, and implement a Future of Work Framework, focused on the identification -through a guidance process- of transferable skills which can be used to future-proof the careers of disadvantaged job seekers and enable sustainable future employment.

So far, we already launched the test-version of the platform and finished the first round of piloting. Commencing in January 2022, we will have a real-life test in each of the partner countries.

2. FYC – Train the Trainer Webinars

Within the last quarter of 2021, the FYC partnership successfully completed the train the trainer programme for selected career guidance practitioner.

The training was structured in 7 Modules:

- Unit 1: Future World of Work
- Unit 2: Future Competences
- Unit 3: Whole Guidance Process
- Unit 4: Tutorial « How to use the tool"
- Unit 5: Providing the guidance session and analysing the report
- Unit 6: Transfer into practice & Quality assurance
- Unit 7: Final Assessment

After transfer the acquired knowledge into practise and collaborating with clients, a final expert talk concluded the full training programme. All participants provided anonymised case studies and transcripts about personal learnings.

We used these talks to fully understand training needs and learnings from our career guidance practitioners, but also to gain valuable feedback from both user groups, facilitators, and clients.
